Title:	Sidewalk Conditions and Transit Amenities Inventory					
Objective:	To identify those existing areas adjacent to existing bus routes and bus stops needing improvement.					
Tasks:	Identify bus shelter locations. Survey all bus route sidewalks within study area boundary. Describe bus stop sidewalk/lighting inventory. Conduct night time survey of lighting conditions at bus stops. Identify the conditions of all sidewalks, internal sidewalks, and pedestrian pathways.					
End Product:	Deficiencies identified will be provided to cities as well as other implementing agencies for immediate implementation or programing.
