Commitment 2045 is the update to the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (formerly known as the Long Range Transportation Plan). This Outreach Toolkit empowers our partners to better involve the people of Broward in this process that plans, implements and builds new projects now and into 2045.

## What is the Metropolitan Transportation Plan?

Commitment 2045, the Metropolitan Transportation Plan for Broward (MTP), is an investment plan for Broward’s transportation system. The plan allocates available federal, state and local funds to maintain and improve the transportation system in the region now and in the future. This plan is one of the MPO’s core products and lays out a vision for the next five years and through 2045.



## How can I help?

The update of the MTP provides a great opportunity for stakeholders, community partners, and members of the public to shape the future of transportation in Broward. As a valued partner of the Broward MPO, this toolkit was developed so that you can help us broaden our outreach efforts and strengthen community relationships. Throughout 2018, we will reach out to the community through workshops, telephone town halls, surveys and social media. We will be working with you to reach as many people in Broward as possible.

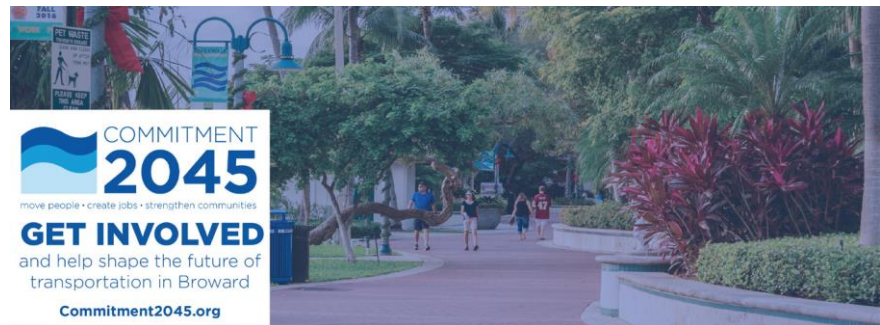

*Last year, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO) celebrated 40 years of being a transportation leader in our region. This year, the Broward MPO will begin development of Commitment 2045, the update to their Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) effort and will continue to look towards the future by planning, implementing and building new projects now and into 2045.*

*Updating the MTP every five years (also known as the Long Range Transportation Plan-LRTP) is one of the Broward MPO's core responsibilities. Commitment 2045, the update of the previous MTP, kicks off this month and will take approximately 18 months to complete. Developing the 2045 plan includes robust public involvement, outreach to stakeholders and collaboration with partner agencies, extensive data collection and analysis, traffic and financial modeling, and other analyses that will produce a plan and prioritize projects for implementation.*

*The update of the MTP provides a great opportunity for stakeholders, community partners, and members of the public to tell us what type of transportation future you envision for our community.*
