HOW TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED PROJECTS

Between July 21st, 2014 and August 21st, 2014, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO) will make available a list of recommended projects for public comment. These projects have been selected with input gathered from Commitment 2040's public outreach effort. Your input was important to us and we have listened. The projects that are recommended for funding represent the outcome of dozens of meetings and polls with your elected officials and over 2,000 members of the public. Additionally, we have coordinated with state, municipal and federal officials in the selection of these improvements.

We need your input again. The projects are divided into three different categories: Affordable Projects (Financially Feasible) are specific improvements we can afford to build over the next 26 years; Unfunded Improvements (Illustrative) are identified projects we cannot currently afford, but would implement should additional funding become available; and New MPO Programs will utilize eligible funds to accelerate the delivery of projects that support our complete streets and other localized initiatives.
