SUMMARY OF EVENT:

- ✓ The staff made a few suggestions regarding our continued outreach efforts
 - Contact the School District Safety Office, to receive possible suggestions of areas that require added safety that have already been identified by the district.
 - Broward Schools Transportation Department may be able to assist with identifying problematic traffic routes.
- ✓ Suggestions were made to address sidewalk connectivity along the corridor especially for students traveling to and from school on foot.
- ✓ Trees/landscaping should be reviewed to add shade to the walking paths along the corridor.
- ✓ Additional traffic calming devices should be implemented along the corridor.
- ✓ Bike paths should be considered for students who travel back and forth from home to school by bike.

FOLLOW UP / ACTION RESULTS: The staff reported that they would provide a list of other departments within the school system that may be able to assist with identifying areas of concern along the SR 7 Corridor. Three proposed areas of interest were: The Transportation Department, a list of Public Schools and Charter Schools affected by the corridor.

EVALUATION OF EVENT: The Broward Schools staff was extremely engaged and willing to assist in providing supplemental information in aiding the project efforts. The feedback provided was very useful.
