

Summary of Event

EVENT: SR 7 Multimodal Improvement Corridor Study
DATE/TIME: Presentation Thursday, January 21, 2016, 2:30pm
LOCATION: Broward College-North Campus (Student Life-Building 46)

SUMMARY OF EVENT:

- ✓ We engaged the audience one-on-one as the participants came in and out of the location and the atmosphere warranted such interaction.
- ✓ One of the students shared that he found the appearance of the buses to be unacceptable on the #14, 42, 55 and 60 routes.
- ✓ The route #55 is frequently late.
- ✓ A rider of routes #14, 42, 55 and 60, finds that the bus driver often begins to operate the bus before passengers are seated.
- ✓ One of the participants noted that SR 7 is an inconvenient route due to the excessive traffic lights. This individual feels that the route would be a lot smoother with less traffic signals.
- ✓ Another participant noted that the #15 bus is often arrives late and that there are not many shelters on this route making it extremely inconvenient to ride the bus in severe weather conditions (e.g rain).

FOLLOW UP / ACTION RESULTS: There were not any follow up courses of action that stemmed from this presentation.

EVALUATION OF EVENT: Although the audience was small we were able to successfully engage the attendees as they arrived. Despite the number of participants the feedback provided was useful regarding the BCT bus routes on the corridor.
