SR 7 Study Area

- Mile-wide corridor centered on SR 7 from south of the Miami-Dade County Line to North of Sample Road.
- Impacts 15 cities, unincorporated Broward County, and the Seminole Tribe of Florida.
- Has the highest transit ridership of any corridor in Broward County with over 20,000 transit riders per day.
- Need was identified in Commitment 2040, Broward's Long Range Transportation Plan

Purpose

To enhance the transit passenger and bicycle and pedestrian experience, identify congestion and safety improvements, develop short-term recommendations that can be carried in the next 3—5 years, and identify longer-term improvements for project development.

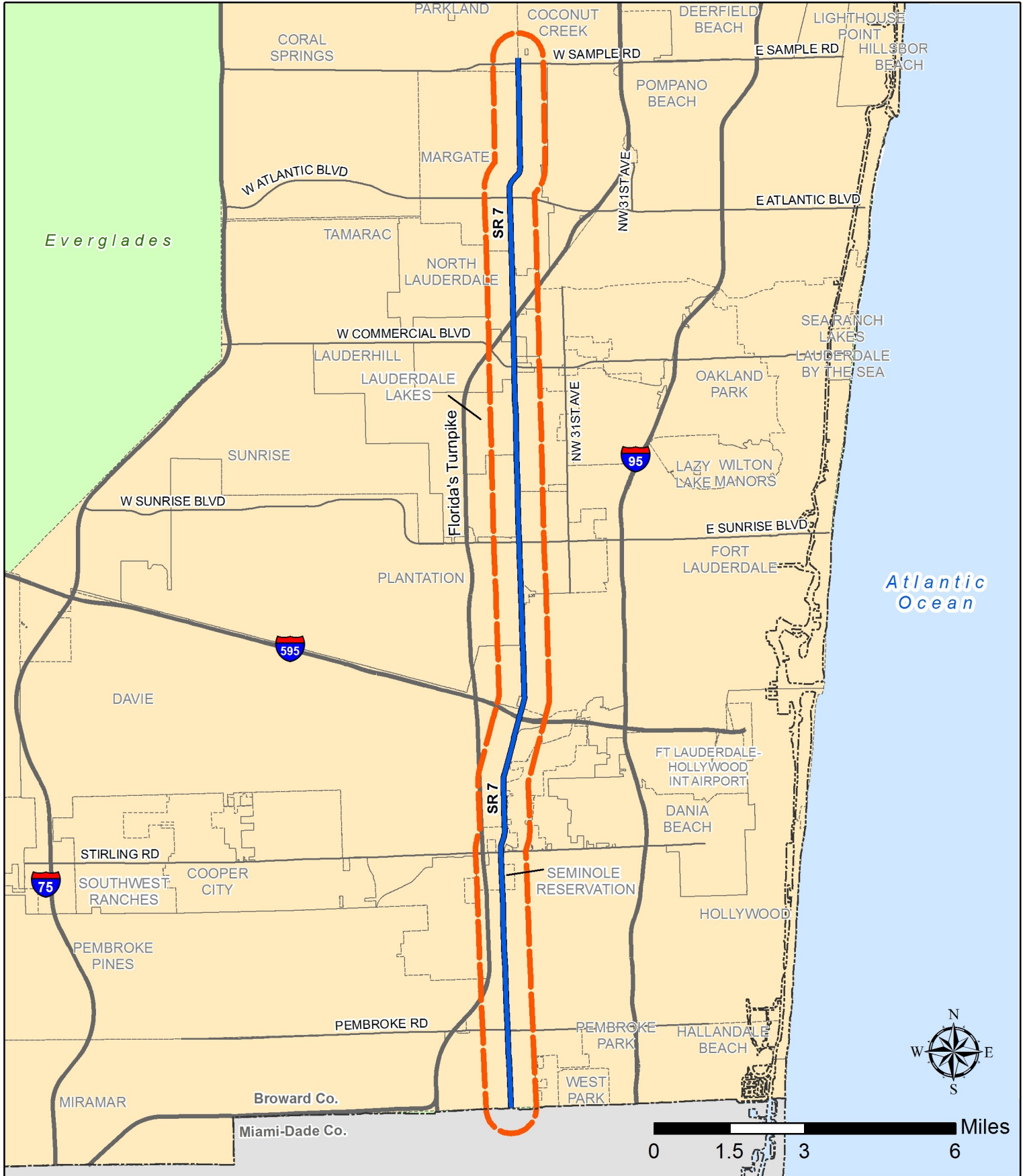
Objectives
