# Previous Efforts

- Development of the Complete Streets Guidelines – unanimously endorsed by the Broward MPO Board on July 12, 2012
- Development of a Model Policy
- Development of a Model Plan Framework
- Selection of a Multi-Modal Level of Service (MMLOS) tool

# Outcomes/Results

- Deerfield Beach
  - Developed and adopted the Deerfield Complete Streets Guidelines
- City of Fort Lauderdale
  - Developed a Complete Streets Manual
  - Developed a Complete Streets Policy
    - Recognized as third-best in the nation by the National Streets Coalition
- Broward County Government
  - Adopted Complete Streets Guidelines
  - Amended the Land Development Code
  - Modify the County's Engineering Standards

The Broward MPO continues to play a leadership role in implementing Complete Streets in Broward. The vision is to create a safe and efficient transportation network that promotes the health and mobility of all residents and visitors by providing high quality multi-modal (pedestrian, bicycle, transit and automobile) access throughout Broward. The Broward MPO endorsed the Complete Streets Guidelines on July 12, 2012 to facilitate and assist local governments in the implementation of Complete Streets. It serves as a template that can be adopted, modified, customized, or expanded based on each community's needs and desires.

Currently, the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) created a "Model Policy Taskforce" and "Model Plan Taskforce" to
